Days 1 - 4: Cape Town / City Bowl, Kensington Place (B&B)

Four days on arrival to settle in and explore the many world famous attractions of the Cape. Kensington Place, a small, contemporary, boutique hotel sheltered beneath the slopes of Table Mountain, is the perfect base from which to unwind and explore all that this cosmopolitan city has to offer.

Days 5 & 6: Cape Winelands / Franschhoek, Klein Genot (B&B)

A short drive brings you to the picturesque village of Franschhoek where spectacular mountain scenery, fine wines and award winning restaurants await you. After a day of wine tasting and visits retreat to your own secluded vineyard hideaway at Klein Genot.

Days 7 & 8: Klein Karoo / Oudtshoorn, Rosenhof Country House (B&B)

Leaving the Cape behind make your way to South Africa's ostrich capital Oudtshoorn in the arid Klein Karoo region. From the peaceful haven that is Rosenhof Country House visit the surrounding ostrich farms, the Cango Caves or enjoy scenic drives over some of South Africa's most spectacular mountain passes.

Days 9 - 11: Garden Route / Plettenberg Bay, Tsala Treetop Lodge (B&B)

Regaining the coast you now enter the heart of the scenic Garden Route where you spend 3 nights at Tsala Treetop Lodge - a symphony of stone, wood, glass and water set high above the floor of the magnificent indigenous forests of the Garden Route. A multitude of attractions and activities await you.

Days 12 & 13: Eastern Cape, Blaauwbosch (FB)

Continuing east spend your final 2 nights at Blaauwbosch, a discrete collection of thatch roofs set in the unspoilt heart of a private game reserve in the malaria free Eastern Cape. Enjoy morning and evening guided game drives in open 4x4 vehicles in search of the 'Big Five' and more.

Day 14:

After a final early morning game drive make your way to the nearby town of Port Elizabeth where you return your rental vehicle and catch your flight to head for home.
